John Lantos



John Lantos has published over 250 journal papers and book chapters and five books on bioethics. He is an advisor to the American Academy of Pediatrics on bioethics issues, and has been an associate editor of the American Journal of Bioethics, Pediatrics, and Perspectives in Biology and Medicine. He was the founding director of the Children's Mercy Bioethics Center at Children's Mercy Hospital and Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Missouri–Kansas City School of Medicine.

Dominic Wilkinson is the Director of Medical Ethics and Professor of Medical Ethics at the Oxford Uehiro Centre for Practical Ethics, University of Oxford. He is a consultant in newborn intensive care at the John Radcliffe Hospital, Oxford.

He has published more than 200 academic articles relating to ethical issues in intensive care for adults, children and newborn infants, and advised on guidance relating to extremely premature infants in UK, Australia and Philippines.

Katie has been involved in research exploring critical care decision making and attitudes towards treatment in neonatal units for over 10 years. This includes the Parents and Neonatal Decisions Study, where critical care decision-making conversations between healthcare professionals and parents were studied to explore how parental support could be improved.
