Received knowledge of elective surgical patients and their trust in hospital staff: a cross-sectional multicentre study

Formål:

Received knowledge of elective surgical patients and their trust in hospital staff: a cross-sectional multicentre study

Metode:

We used the following instruments in this cross-sectional multicentre study: Hospital Patients' Received Knowledge (HPRK) and a questionnaire to measure trust in an emergency department. The main variables were 40 items about received knowledge and 3 items on trust in physicians.

Resultat:

There is a positive association between the patients' self-reported knowledge that they received related to the hospital stay and their trust in the physicians (Pearson's r between the knowledge index and the trust index, $r = 0.416$, $P < 0.01$).

Konklusjon:

The study suggests that successful patient information is positively related to patients' trust in hospital staff.
